NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

TAKE NOTICE that the Registrar is in receipt of a notice of opposition filed by FERRERO S.p.A. (The Opponent), of Piazzale Pietro Ferrero 1, Alba, Italy, against trademark Application No. 4712.07, filed on the 22nd day of June, 2007, by GRUPO BIMBO S.A.B. DE C.V. (The Applicant), of prologación Paseo de la Reforma No. 1000 Peña Blanca Santa Fe, C.P. 01210, México City, México, for the registration of the following trademark, as proprietor thereof:

CHOCO SORPRESA

The Opponent opposes the above trademark Application on the grounds that:


1. The Opponent Ferrero S.p.A. (S.p.A. stands for joint stock company), is the World's 4th largest confectionery producer. It was founded in 1946 in Italy, where the headquarters and many production facilities are still located, with its base of operations at Piazzale Pietro Ferrero 1, Alba. The word "Piazzale" is the Italian translation of "Square" and the name of the square itself, derives from the Opponent's founder, Pietro Ferrero. The Ferrero family still leads the Opponent company.
2. The Opponent manufactures chocolate and other confectionery products, including breath mints, chocolate bars, chocolate/hazelnut spread, and espresso-filled chocolates. The company sells its sweets in Belize as well as throughout the Caribbean, Americas, Asia, Australia, Europe, and the Middle East.
3. The Opponent has a prior registration in Belize of the trade mark "KINDER SORPRESA" under Reg. No. 3180.05 registered on the 21st day of November, 2005 (also referred to as the "Opponent Mark"). "Sorpresa" is the Italian translation of "Surprise". The Opponent's SORPRESA mark is also registered alone in a large number of countries throughout the world and has been registered for decades.
4. The Opponent currently markets and distributes chocolate products under the Opponent Mark as part of its extensive brand list found at the Opponent's website <http://www.ferrero.com/eng/index.html> and also attached in part hereto as Exhibits A and B.
5. The Opponent's products are of vast renown, famous worldwide and include, among others, its leading products and instantly recognizable trademarks NUTELLA, TIC TAC, FERRERO ROCHER and the Opponent Mark, KINDER SORPRESA, the marks of which are all registered in a large number of countries around the world. Further, Nutella is No. 1 top seller in the World for sweet spreads while Tic Tac holds the same position for mints, as well as Ferrero Rocher for pralines and the Opponent Mark KINDER SORPRESA for chocolate eggs, making it extremely untenable that the average consumer would not be aware of the Opponent's core products line, which includes the Opponent Mark.
6. The Opponent is currently the only Italian corporation having a brand with a turnover of over One Billion Dollars in United States currency, namely its KINDER mark, including the Opponent Mark. Many brands of the Opponent bear the KINDER mark before the product mark thus the KINDER SORPRESA mark can easily be split into KINDER (the umbrella mark) and SORPRESA (the brand itself).
7. The Opponent owns, in its own name or through its sister companies belonging as well to the Ferrero International group, nearly 40,000 trademarks throughout the world, among which about 800 refers to the "SURPRISE/SORPRESA" family of marks, namely "SURPRISE, KINDER SURPRISE, KINDER SORPRESA and many device marks related thereto. Gross sales of the Kinder Surprise/Sorpresa egg, which entered the market 30 years ago, amount to 738 million dollars in 2007. Easy reference can even be made to the Opponent Mark in "Wikipedia", the largest online multilingual free-content encyclopedia on the Internet, found at the website http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Kinder_Surprise, also attached hereto as Exhibit C.
8. The Opponent has started legal proceedings against the Applicant, Grupo Bimbo on several occasions due to a clear policy of passing off conducted by Grupo Bimbo.
9. The goods of the said Application No. 4712.07 are of a similar or related description to the goods protected under the Opponent's trade mark and are likely to deceive or cause confusion.
10. The trade mark which the Applicant has applied to register under the said Application No. 4712.07 is so similar to the Opponent's trademark and as such is likely to deceive and/or cause confusion.
11. By reason of the reputation, well known character and earlier use acquired by the Opponent's trade mark already in use internationally and in Belize mainly in relation to the goods for which it is registered, use of the Applicant's mark sought to be registered would be deceptive and/or confusing and so disentitled to protection in a Court of Justice.





12. The said application No. 4712.07 contravenes section 37(2) (b) of the Trade Marks Act, Chapter 257 of the Laws of Belize, Revised Edition 2000 and amendments and should not be registered by virtue of the fact that it is similar to the Opponent's trade mark as earlier trade mark and is to be registered for goods or services identical with or similar to those for which the Opponent's trade mark as earlier trade mark is protected which would cause a likelihood of confusion on the part of th public, which includes the likelihood of association with the Opponent's trade mark as earlier trade mark.
13. The Opponent respectfully requests that the subject application for the Applicant's trade mark be refused registration.









The Applicant is required to submit a response to this notice, to the Registrar, no later than 30 days from the date of publication of this notice.
