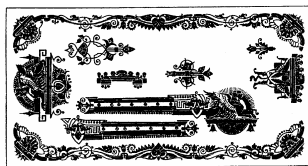

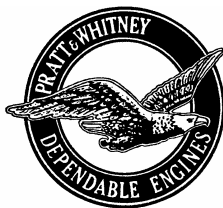

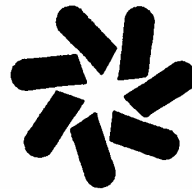

TAKE NOTICE that the Registrar is in receipt of an answer, filed on the 27th day of July, 2007, by **British Sky Broadcasting Group Plc** (The Applicant), of Grant Way, Isleworth, Middlesex TW7 5QD, United Kingdom, to the opposition by **GUARDANT, INC.**, (The Opponent), of 1030 Delta Boulevard, Atlanta, Georgia, United States of America, filed on the 13th day of June, 2007, against trade mark application Nos. 4066.06 and 4067.06, filed on the 31st day of August, 2006, by **British Sky Broadcasting Group Plc** (The Applicant), for the registration of the following trade marks, as proprietors thereof:

The Applicant hereby gives notice that the following are the grounds on which it relies as supporting the above trademarks-

1. BSKyB is one of the largest entertainment companies in the United Kingdom. Its shares are listed on the New York and London stock exchanges, and its total gross revenue for the year ending June 30, 2006 was £4,148 million (approximately \$7,879,740 U.S. Dollars).
2. BSKyB is the owner of more than 1800 SKY and SKY-formative trademark registrations and applications in more than 85 countries around the world (the "SKY Family of Trademarks"). The SKY Family of Trademarks include: SKY, SKY NEWS, SKY SPORTS, SKY EVENT, SKY PREMIERE, SKY VIEW and SKY KIDS, and other combinations of SKY with words and/or designs.
3. By virtue of BSKyB's (and its licensees') long and continuous use of the SKY trademark in many countries throughout the world, the trademark SKY has become a well-known mark within the meaning of Article 6 *bis* (1) of the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and ought to be protected in Belize as such.
4. BSKyB's explanation and answers follow:

BSkyB and Its Internationally Well-Known SKY Family of Trademarks

5. BSKyB operates the leading pay television satellite broadcasting service in the United Kingdom and The Republic of Ireland, and has used SKY as part of its company name, as a trademark and as a house mark extensively and continuously for over 20 years.
6. BSKyB's earliest trademark application for a SKY-formative mark is the Swiss SKY CHANNEL registration.
7. Since that time, BSKyB has expanded its use of the SKY brand and has developed a significant portfolio of SKY trademarks around the world.
8. Today, BSKyB manages a portfolio of more than 500 SKY and SKY-formative trademark registrations and applications in the following 54 territories: Albania, Austria, Belarus, Benelux, Bulgaria, China, Croatia, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Estonia, European Community, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Guernsey, Hong Kong, Hungary, Iceland, India, Indonesia, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Jersey, Korea (South), Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Macedonia, Malaysia, Moldova, Monaco, Morocco, Norway, Poland, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia & Montenegro, Singapore, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Turkey, Ukrainian SSR, and the United Kingdom.
9. By way of a license dated December 30, 1997 (as subsequently amended and novated), Applicant gave an exclusive license to News America Incorporated ("NAI") to use SKY and SKY-formative trademarks in connection with Direct To Home ("DTH") satellite television services and related goods and services in more than 34 territories including: Argentina, Bangladesh, **Belize**, Bhutan, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, India, Italy, Maldives, Mexico, Nepal, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, San Marino, Seychelles, South Korea, Sri Lanka, United States, Uruguay, Vatican City and Venezuela. These countries will be collectively referred to as the "Licensed Territories."
10. Today, NAI manages more than 1300 SKY and SKY-formative trademark registrations and applications in the Licensed Territories.

11. In total, BSKyB owns more than 1800 SKY and SKY-formative trademark registrations and applications in more than 85 countries, including Belize. In fact, BSKyB owns registrations for SKY KIDS, SKY VIEW, SKY SPORTS, SKY NEWS, SKY PREMIERE and SKY EVENTS in Belize.
12. Of all of these registrations and applications, more than 500 of them are in Class 35, which is the Class of the application that is the subject of this proceeding.
13. BSKyB and its licensees use SKY and the SKY Family of Trademarks in throughout the world in connection with a variety of goods and services.

i. The United Kingdom and Ireland

14. BSKyB operates the leading pay television satellite broadcasting service in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland. As of the end of 2006, there were more than 18 million households in the United Kingdom received SKY-branded television channels.
15. BSKyB has an active website at www.sky.com that provides information about BSKyB and its SKY-branded goods and services.

ii. Mexico

16. SKY and SKY-formative trademarks have been used in Mexico since 1996 through its licensee NAI and NAI's sub-licensee, Innova, S. de R.L. de C.V., and its subsidiary, Corporacion Novavision, S. de R.L. de C.V. (collectively "Innova") in association with DTH services and related goods and services. Innova's DTH business is commonly referred to as "SKY Mexico."
17. As of the end of 2006, there were more than 1.4 million subscribers to SKY Mexico's DTH service.
18. SKY Mexico has an active website at www.sky.com.mx, launched in 1997, that provides information about SKY Mexico.

iii. Brazil

19. SKY and SKY-formative trademarks have been used in Brazil by Applicant through its licensee NAI and NAI's sub-licensee, Sky Brasil Serviços Ltda ("SKY Brasil") in association with the DIRECT TO HOME ("DTH") television satellite service offered in Brazil since 1996.
20. SKY Brasil is the largest digital television operator in South America, having more than 1.45 million subscribers in Brazil, which corresponds to a 31.9% share of the total television subscribers in Brazil as of December 2006.
21. SKY Brasil has an active website at www.sky.com.br (its previous site, www.skytv.com.br, was launched in 2000) that provides information about SKY Brasil's goods and services in Brazil.

iv. India

22. On August 8, 2006, a new DTH platform was launched in India under the name TATA SKY. That platform is operated by a company called Tata Sky Limited, an indirect licensee of Applicant, and a joint venture between Tata Sons, Ltd. and STAR, a wholly-owned subsidiary of News Corporation.
23. TATA SKY has an active website at www.tatasky.com that provides information about TATA SKY's goods and services in India.

v. Italy

24. SKY and SKY-formative trademarks have been used in Italy by Applicant, through its licensee NAI and NAI's sub-licensee SKY Italia, in association with the DIRECT TO HOME ("DTH") television satellite service offered in Italy under the trademark SKY since 2003.
25. SKY Italia is the main digital satellite pay television service in Italy, and in addition to providing DTH services, it offers SKY branded channels for movies, sports and news.
26. As of December 2006, SKY Italia has more than 4 million subscribers.
27. SKY Italia has an active website at www.skylife.it (its previous site, www.skytv.it, was launched on June 28, 2003) providing information about its services.

vi. Other Countries

28. In addition to all of the uses of SKY in the countries discussed above, BSKyB's SKY-branded programming (i.e.: SKY SPORTS and SKY NEWS) are distributed in many countries throughout the world. For example, news feeds from BSKyB's SKY NEWS program are frequently distributed to news outlets throughout the world. Sky Italia's SKY TG 24 program is aired on a television station in Canada. BSKyB's SKY NEWS INTERNATIONAL program is broadcast worldwide.
29. Moreover, starting in September of 2006 BSKyB's SKY NEWS INTERNATIONAL program was available on all Virgin Atlantic flights extending to 27 destinations worldwide.
30. In sum, it is clear that BSKyB's SKY and SKY family of trademarks are known to many millions of people around the world, and is a notorious and well-known mark.

Guardant, Inc. and Its Opposition

31. Guardant, Inc. has, based on a Class 35 registration that it owns for SKY TEAM, filed this opposition against BSKyB's applications to register SKY (logo) and SKY (word).
32. As was stated at the outset, BSKyB's applications are to register its two SKY marks in Classes 9, 16, 35, 38 and 41. BSKyB assumes that Guardant's opposition only extends to BSKyB's application in Class 35, and BSKyB respectfully requests that the Trademark Office grant its registration in Classes 9, 16, 38 and 41.
33. Guardant has not provided any meaningful evidence of its use of SKY or SKYTEAM, or that its mark was used prior to BSKyB's use of SKY. Guardant's unsupported allegations should not be given much weight, especially in light of BSKyB's strong evidence of the fame of its SKY family of trademarks.
34. BSKyB intends to file a petition seeking to invalidate Guardant's registrations for SKYTEAM on the ground that they are likely to cause confusion with BSKyB's famous SKY trademark.

WHEREFORE the Applicant prays that its applications be registered because, inter alia, the SKYTEAM trademark dilutes the SKY trademarks.

The Applicant hereby gives notice that the following are the grounds on which it relies as supporting the above service mark-

1. The mark of the Applicant is not similar to the Opponent's mark.
2. The only common feature between the Applicant's mark and that of the Opponent's mark is the use of the words "Coco Plum" and "Resort". Save and except these words, there is no similarity between the Applicant's mark and the Opponent's mark.
3. Registration of the COCO PLUM ISLAND RESORT trademark did not, at the time of registration, and does not presently confer on the registered proprietor thereof the exclusive right to the use of the word "COCOPLUM, the name of a fruit. Such words are the property of mankind and it would be wrong to allow any individual or company to hold a monopoly on them.
4. The Opponent's mark is easily distinguishable from the Applicant's mark as it is expressly clear from the name itself that the mark pertains to an ISLAND and not a community of home owners.

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5. The Applicant's trademark has gained both local and international recognition as a real estate development project situated on 224 acres on the mainland of the Placencia Peninsula. The Opponent's mark on the other hand is utilized exclusively as an island resort, situated off the coast of Belize.
 6. The Applicant's mark seeks protection in totally different classes from that of the Opponent and for which the Opponent is not protected under the Trade Marks Act. In particular, the Applicant seeks protection under International Class 35 which deals with advertising; business management; business administration and office functions and International Class 36 which deals with insurance; financial affairs; monetary affairs; real estate affairs. The only class under which the Opponent is protected is International Class 43, which deals with services for providing food and drink and temporary accommodation. The types of coverage sought by the Applicant and Opponent are therefore distinct and dissimilar.
 7. The Applicant has since the registration of the Opponent's mark incorporated and registered COCOPLUM OWNERS ASSOCIATION LIMITED, a limited liability company comprised of all homeowners of the Applicant's development project, COCOPLUM A RESORT COMMUNITY.
 8. There is no likelihood of confusion between the Applicant's mark and the Opponent's mark which may mislead the public into thinking that the marks are associated and owned by the same company.
 9. The Applicant contends that there is no visual and/or aural similarity through the dominant components of the two marks. Firstly, the Opponent's name comprises two words "COCO PLUM" while the Applicant's name comprises one "COCOPLUM". The second word in the Opponent's mark ("ISLAND") automatically makes a distinction as that term is not used in the Applicant's mark. The Applicant's mark "COCOPLUM A RESORT COMMUNITY" draws a further distinction from the Opponent's mark as it indicates quite clearly that it is not an "Island Resort" but rather a "Resort Community". The font, design and perceptual connotations of the two marks are also easily distinguishable.
 10. There is no likelihood of passing off one mark for the other which would lead the public to believe that the services offered by the Applicant are the services of the Opponent.
 - (a) The Applicant does not by the use of its mark make a representation to the public, whether intentionally or not, which would lead or is likely to lead the public to believe that the services offered by the Applicant are the services of the Opponent;
 - (b) The Applicant's use of its mark or the registration thereof is not calculated to injure the business or goodwill of the Opponent;
 - (c) The Applicant's use of its mark will not cause any loss or damage to the business or goodwill of the Opponent;
 - (d) The Opponent will not suffer any loss or damage to its business or goodwill due to any erroneous belief that the Applicant's services or use of the mark are the services or mark of the Opponent.
 11. The applicant does not admit that there is a distinctive character or repute of the Opponent's mark so as to prevent the registration of the Applicant's mark.
 12. In the event that there is a distinctive character or repute of the Opponent's mark, the use of the Applicant's mark has not taken advantage of and has not been of detriment to the distinctive character or repute of the Opponent's mark and will not take advantage of or be of detriment to such character or repute.
